Our team is working to build financial capability across all generations, to equip the retirees of today and tomorrow. We are increasing our focus on low income and vulnerable New Zealanders, many of whom are facing a retirement with little or no savings.

Building financial capability is about driving sustainable behaviour change and our workplace and community programmes aim to bring about an underlying shift in the way people think about money. They are 6-10 module face to face programmes, that are delivered to small to medium sized groups.

We need facilitators with a passion for making a difference to deliver our programmes.

Commission-Affiliated facilitators will be engaged as independent contractors for delivery of each individual programme. They will be offered work on a case by case basis, so this opportunity is ideal for those looking for something that will fit in around other commitments.

As a Commission-Affiliated facilitator:

- You must be able to demonstrate financial services knowledge, as well as facilitation (or some kind of delivery e.g. Presentation) experience, and, ideally, will have qualifications in at least one.
- You will support and guide participants through their personal journey of self-assessment, reflection and new learning.
- You will have an understanding of adult learning.
- You will be adaptable to the needs of participants and be driven to help them succeed.
- You will be self-leading, organised and thorough.
- Your style will be positive and energising.
- You must be passionate about creating sustainable behaviour change.
- You will have the ability to relate to people of different cultures and ethnicities, socio-economic groups, income levels and varying levels of financial capability.
- You will be able to exhibit impartiality and demonstrate the difference between information and advice.
